# Manual handling safety checklist >

2. Are your workers properly supervised, particularly when carrying out manual handling tasks?						
3. Hazard identification. Have you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• identified all manual-handling tasks that may be a risk to health and safety?</li> <li>• reviewed your injury and incident statistics to determine what tasks have caused manual handling injuries in the past?</li> <li>• consulted with workers to determine which tasks they consider a safety issue or risk of injury?</li> </ul>						
5. Have you taken reasonably practicable steps to control the risks associated with manual handling tasks. See NT WorkSafe information bulletin series 06.02 - Manual handling, which includes: care for your back, moving trolleys, stacking shelves, drum handling and stacking cartons on pallets.
